What we do, how a project runs, and exactly what it costs.
Everything is here, in writing, before you commit to
anything.



GETTING STARTED

From first enquiry to finished garment.

Every project is different, but the route is always the same. You only pay for the stages you actually need, and nothing begins until the scope and the price are agreed in writing.

01 Enquiry

Tell us what you are making and where you are up to. No cost, no commitment. If it is not something we can help with, we will say so and point you somewhere that can.

02 Consultation — £75

A 45 minute call covering your brief, references, garment category, quantities and timeline. You leave with a one page summary: the route we recommend, the stages you need, and an indicative cost.

03 Written quote

If you want to go ahead, we put together a full written quote setting out the scope, what is included, how many revision rounds, the deliverables and the timeline.

04 Deposit and start

A 50% deposit confirms the booking and your slot in the schedule. Work begins.

05 Development, stage by stage

You see and sign off each stage before the next one starts. Nothing moves forward on an assumption.

06 Sign off and handover

Final payment, then everything is released: patterns, files, tech packs, samples. Approved patterns stay on file so repeat work never starts from scratch.

What to send us at the start

Sketches or reference images. Measurements, or the size you want to work to. A reference garment if you have one, even if the fit is wrong. Fabric details if you have chosen them. Your deadline. None of it needs to be polished. A photo of a drawing is a perfectly good place to begin.

A note on capacity

We take a limited number of projects at a time so each one gets proper attention. If we cannot meet your timeline we will say so at the consultation rather than accept the work and rush it.



WAYS TO WORK WITH US

Four routes through the studio.

Most projects follow one of these. Prices shown are the starting point for a simple garment. Full range overleaf.

Pattern only

FROM £145

A complete pattern drafted from your sketch, reference garment or brief, digitised and handed over for you to take to whoever is making it.

- All pieces with seam allowances, notches, grainlines and cut instructions
- Digital files in your preferred format
- One revision round included

The pattern has not been tested in cloth. We would recommend whoever makes it up produces a toile first.

Pattern and toile

FROM £275

The pattern, then proven physically before anyone cuts anything expensive.

- Everything in Pattern only
- Calico toile, a plain test version made in undyed cotton
- One correction round, with the pattern updated
- Approved pattern kept on file

Full sample

FROM £440

Everything above, plus the garment made up properly in your fabric. The piece you use for fit sign off, photography, and as the reference for your manufacturer.

- Everything in Pattern and toile
- Finished sample made to production standard
- Fabric supplied by you, quantity confirmed after the pattern stage

You already have a pattern

REVIEW £65

Bring us a pattern from elsewhere and we will assess it: whether it is complete, correctly marked up and sound in construction. The £65 is credited against the work that follows.

- Production ready and proven in cloth, we go straight to making your sample
- Not yet toiled, or problems found, we toile and correct first, quoted after the review

Why we always toile before cutting your fabric

We will not cut a client's final fabric against a pattern that has not been tested. Your fabric is finite and usually expensive. A toile costs a fraction of it and finds the problems while they are still easy to fix. This is the one thing we do not make optional.

Complexity, defined

Simple. Unstructured, few pieces, unlined. A t-shirt, joggers, a simple skirt. **Standard.** Structured, with fastenings or set in sleeves. A shirt, trousers, a dress. **Complex.** Tailored, lined, many pieces, or technical. A jacket, a coat, corsetry, outerwear. Your tier is confirmed at consultation, before anything is quoted.

Also on request: pattern tracing, digitisation, digital file exports, pattern storage, measurement specs, size charts, care label copy, DTF, embroidery, label sourcing, sample alterations, and one to one tuition. Priced per project, subject to capacity. Minimum project value £150.

**IMPORTANT**

How we work, in writing.

Quotes

Every project starts with a written quote agreed by both parties, defining scope, revision rounds and deliverables. Changes after agreement are quoted as additions.

Deposits and payment

50% deposit before work begins, balance on completion and before files or samples are released. Production orders are payable in full upfront. Factory invoices, shipping and duties are collected before orders are placed. We do not carry production costs.

Late payment

Overdue invoices carry interest at 8% above the Bank of England base rate plus the statutory fixed compensation, under the Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998. Work pauses until the account is settled.

Revisions

Each service includes a defined number of revision rounds, set out in your quote. A correction round covers up to three changes and a revised toile or sample.

Turnaround

Indicative and dependent on workload, confirmed in writing with your quote. Pattern 5 to 10 working days. Toile 7 to 14. Finished sample 10 to 20. Tech pack 5 to 7.

Rush fee

Work required faster than the agreed turnaround carries a 25% surcharge, confirmed in writing on your quote.

Your fabric and materials

Fabric quantities are confirmed after the pattern stage, so you are not buying blind. We hold client materials free for 30 days after completion. After that, storage is £15 per month or we return them at your cost. Unclaimed items may be disposed of after 90 days and written notice.

Patterns and storage

Digital pattern files are stored free and indefinitely, so repeat work never starts from scratch. Physical patterns are returned with your final delivery, or stored twelve months at £30 per pattern. Reprinting later is £25 plus materials.

Ownership

Patterns, tech packs and design files become yours on receipt of final payment. Until then all work remains the property of Patrwmaw.

Our manufacturing partners

Where we coordinate production, all communication with factories goes through us and factory details remain confidential. You get established relationships and technical oversight without managing a factory yourself.

Cancellation

Deposits are non refundable once work has begun. Work completed beyond the deposit value is invoiced pro rata.

Confidentiality

Your designs, patterns and commercial information stay between us. We will not show your work publicly without written permission.
